

Steve Bishop and Bill Reed made a presentation on JS8, JS8 Call and the use of the Net Time App. JS8 is a "keyboard to keyboard" application. Bill connected with a friend of his in Wyoming and each demonstrated how JS8 functions and transmitted/received messages between stations. Many members asked questions regarding the use of the mode and also the ease of use of the App.

Secretary's report – Motion to accept as published – Steve Froggatt, seconded by Mike Reid. Vote – all in favor.

Treasurer's report – Bob McAlister presented the Budget for 2025 and detailed several changes regarding expenditures.

After discussion and adding an item for renewing N4EAR fees for \$35, the budget passed. The monthly Treasury report was published in the last newsletter.

This group is mobilized during storm events to gather and provide a safe environment for farm animals – so their mission is quite unique.
