

Brought back memories – back then we all had EWOL (Englewood On-Line) e-mails.

What the heck – I tried that 697 number and eventually a lady picked up and said 'Hello' in a guarded voice. Nancy?? I said – and then Yeeesss?? Came back – Who is this? She eventually remembered who the hell I was. She is still here - still with license plate that John had - that I saw on McCall yesterday! Glad she picked up the phone from a strange 941 number.

We had a good chat. She also remembered Dr. John Combs, **K9JPC**, later **W4VMD**, another name the old club members would latch onto. He was a vetinary doctor. Lost him in 2010.
