### NXDN Radio Signal Report Test for Waterfest:

Thanks to Bernie for testing waterfest coverage with me today.

These new digital radios performed well at the critical 3 Dry Pit parking lot gates. Over 90% copy. The boardwalk, pavilion, Chadwick park wet pits and security base were previously tested successfully last year. Vendor area was also strong.

Used **Charlotte north** repeater. Laurel repeater did not seem to work. More testing there is planned. However Along Beach road was mostly unusable. other areas were unusable or spotty, such as sand areas and sidewalks other than along north beach road.

Other than weather events, Waterfest may be the next likely emergency event location along with PG airport or toxic train derailment. Therefore, it is **strongly recommended that creating a NXDN West repeater be prioritized for reliable West County EMCOM coverage.** 73 Jim W4AII AEC CCFLARES
